Major activities cont	<ul> <li>Paddock and native trees have been fenced off for protection during construction.</li> </ul>
	Trees nominated for removal have been taken down and removed from site.
	<ul> <li>Installation of solar tracking mechanisms has commenced.</li> </ul>
	• The 'Golden Row' – the first row of solar panels – has been installed.
Community	<ul> <li>Logs and stumps removed from site have been donated to the Goulburn Broken Catchment Management Authority and will be repurposed for use in local waterways to create habitat and prevent erosion.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Gransolar are interested in liaising with local community groups to support small fundraising opportunities. For further information please call 0418 142 173.</li> </ul>

Traffic	<ul> <li>In accordance with development approval, access to and from the site for all commercial vehicles, including large deliveries and waste collection is via the Winton-Glenrowan Rd, rather than the Hume Highway directly.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Approved traffic changes have been implemented on the Winton-Glenrowan Road. This includes lower speeds for the safe entry and exit of vehicles, and potential short-term road closures.</li> </ul>
